School Cross Country

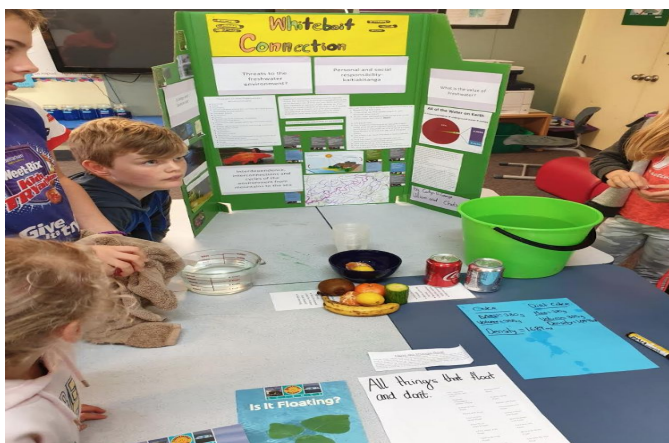
