Blade and Brayden are checking the volume of liquid in their pipette.

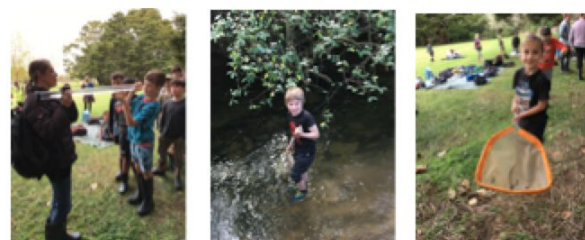


To continue our theme of working collaboratively for Kotahitanga, students in Takahe follow instructions to prepare a slice.
