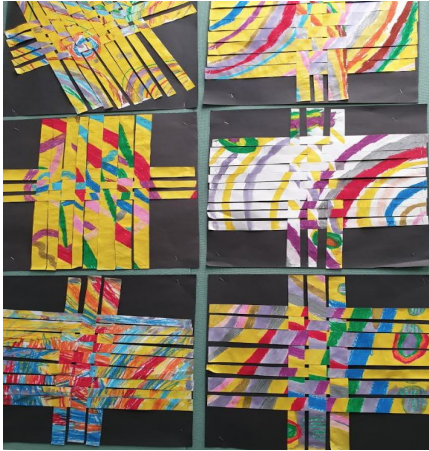
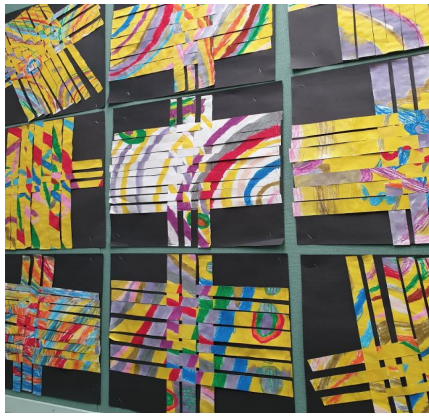
Discovery Learning
