Garden to Table News

A recipe to try in the holidays!



PAKIPAKI  
(MĀORI BREAD)



**Season:** all year  
**Type:** starter or as part of a meal  
**Difficulty:** medium  
**Makes:** approximately 16 pieces (so you may wish to double it for a full class)  
**Source:** Maria Wilson, Kitchen Specialist, Dominion Road Primary

**Equipment:**

- Oven tray
- Large bowl for mixing
- Measuring cups
- Measuring spoons
- Sieve
- Knife
- Jug (for water/milk mixture)

**Ingredients:**

- 4 cups plain flour (+ extra for dusting and kneading)
- 4 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- milk and water in equal measures

**How to make it:**

1. Preheat the oven to 200 °C. Line a tray with baking paper.
  2. Sift the flour, baking powder and salt into a bowl. Make a well in the middle.
  3. Mix the water and milk in a jug in equal quantities, start with 1 cup of each and add more as required.
  4. Gradually add the water/milk mixture into the bowl, stirring with a knife (or your hand) to get a soft dough.
  5. Turn out onto a clean, floured surface and knead lightly, adding more flour if needed. You want the dough to just come together, so it can be easily transferred to the tray. Do not overwork the dough or the bread will be tough.
- PAKIPAKI (Māori Bread)**
6. Transfer the dough to a baking tray and shape into a rectangle or round shape approximately 2 cm high. Cut through with a knife into even pieces, but do not separate.
  7. Bake for approximately 20 minutes. The bread should sound hollow with tapped on the bottom and be evenly coloured.

**Notes:**

This is an unleavened bread (made without yeast). The recipe was handed down to Maria by her Grandmother and in her family they had several other names for the bread including flat bread, cartwheel bread and pakipaki.

The recipe is easily doubled: for every cup of flour add 1 teaspoon baking powder.

You can use this same recipe for dough boys / kine kine / plastic potatoes (dumplings) for your 'boil up' pot.
