Health and Safety

- **Sun Safe** - It is really important that we keep our children safe from the sun. Please make sure you have applied sunscreen before they arrive at school and that they do have a school hat. We now have bucket style school hats on sale at school.
- **Road Safety** - If you collect your child from school, please make sure you come into the school grounds to collect your child from their teacher. Waiting in your car, calling them to you or waiting on the kerbside causes a danger as there is so much traffic movement around the school at the end of the day.
- **Bus** - If your children travel by school bus, it is important to let us know before 2pm on the day if any changes have been made and your child is not travelling by bus. If the bus roll indicates that no changes have been made, I am obliged to put your child on the bus. It is very stressful for them if they know that they are not on the bus, but you have not made contact with us. If you are not home and the bus drops your child off, that is a danger. Contacting school after 2pm, may mean that we do not get the message in time, especially if Jan is away from the office.
